Name of beer Black Scotch

Type of beer Peated Scotch Ale

Description A combination of traditional Scottish ale yeast and dark caramel malts are responsible for the aroma of fresh baked banana bread wafting from your glass after the initial pour of this dark, deceptively smooth, malt forward winter warmer. The fruity esters responsible for this brief phenomenon quickly take a back seat to a bouquet of caramel covered toffee with undertones of roast malt and an ever-so-slight hint of peat. While not particularly evident in the aroma, the deftly dispensed portion of peat smoked malt used in this brew shows itself as you bring your glass in for the first sip, pretending to be the dominant flavor for a very short lived moment before blending into a medium bodied, caramelly, malty masterpiece with more evidence of the fruity esters from the initial pour playing on your palate. A company and tap house favorite, we keep saying we won't brew it again, but every year we do. This really might be the last time we whip this one up, so don't miss out!
